Sarvapalli Radha krishnan Jayanti (Teacher Day: 05thSeptember)



Sarvepalli Radha Krishnan (5 September 1888 – 17 April 1975) was an Indian philosopher, academic, and statesman who served as the first Vice President of India (1952–1962) and the second President of India (1962–1967). Servapalli Radha krishnan was born in a Telugu-speaking Niyogi Brahmin family, in Tiruttani in the erstwhile Madras Presidency. His father's name was Sarvepalli Veeraswami and his mother's name was Sarvepalli Sita (Sitamma).

When he became the President of India, some of his students and friends requested him to allow them to celebrate his birth day, on 5 September .He replied, “Instead of celebrating my birthday, it would be my proud privilege if September 5th is observe das Teachers 'Day” .His birth day has since been celebrated as Teacher's Day in India.

Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti (02nd October)



Mohandas Karamch and Gandhi (2 October 1869 –30 January 1948) was an Indian lawyer, anti-colonial nationalist, and political ethicist, who employed nonviolent resistance to lead the successful campaign for India's independence from British Rule, and in turn in spire movements for civil rights and freedom across the world. The honorific Mahatma(Sanskrit:"great-souled", "venerable"), first applied to him in 1914 in South Africa, is now used throughout the world .B.S.B.A. celebrates his birth anniversary every year ,and on that day different competitions like poster competition etc are conducted.

National Unity Day (31st October)



Vallabhbhai Jhaverbhai Patel (31 October 1875–15 December 1950), popularly known as **Sardar Patel**, was an Indian politician. He served as the first Deputy Prime Minister of India. He was an Indian barrister, a senior leader of the Indian National Congress and a founding father of the Republic of India who played a leading role in the country's struggle for independence and guided its integration into a united, independent nation.

His birthday is celebrated as “**National Unity Day**” every year, & BSBA participates with zeal into this.

Vivekanand Jayanti (International Youth Day:12th January)

Swami Vivekananda (12 January 1863 – 4 July 1902), born **Narendra nath Datta**, was an Indian Hindu monk, a chief disciple of the 19th - century Indian mystic Ramakrishna. He was a key figure in the introduction of the Indian philosophies of Vedanta and Yoga to the Western world and
